

Accessibility Features - Assistive Touch

How to Access:

1. Open **SETTINGS**
2. Tap **GENERAL**
3. Tap **ACCESSIBILITY**
4. Under '**INTERACTION**', tap **ASSISTIVE TOUCH**.
5. Once you turn on this feature, you are able to customize Assistive Touch to fit your needs.
 - a. Customize the number of icons to include in the Assistive Touch feature
 - b. Change the icons to personalize various controls such as volume, muting, screenshots, lock rotation, and more. To change, simply tap the icon you would like to modify and select which feature you would like to replace it with.
 - c. Pinch: You can enable this feature to allow you to use one finger to 'pinch' and do things such as zoom, which requires two fingers.

How to Activate:

6. A small square will appear on your screen; this square will follow throughout the whole system and will appear anytime you open an app. This is the assistive touch button.
7. Once tapped, it will allow you to use any of the assistive touch features you have customized.
